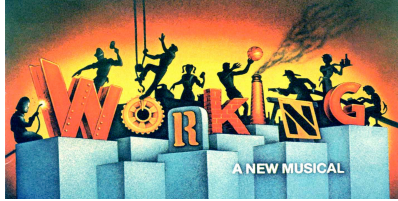

The **NOT SO COMMON PLAYERS'** 2010 fall production, **WORKING, A MUSICAL** is set to open on Friday, October 15, 2010. The show runs for two weekends: Friday through Sunday October 15 – 17 and then Thursday through Sunday October 21 – 24.

WORKING is based on the bestselling book of the same name by Studs Turkel. The book is a collection of interviews with a wide range of American workers including an ironworker, a waitress, a stone mason, a trucker, a housewife, a UPS delivery man, a teacher, a millworker, a supermarket checker and a retiree. It chronicles a day in the life of these average American workers', from the Monday morning blues to the second shift blahs. The musical takes these interviews and weaves together monologues and songs exploring the workers hopes and aspirations as they take us through their daily routine.

WORKING is directed, designed and choreographed by Thomas Dalton Bambury, with musical direction by Olga Martinez. The talented ensemble cast of 20 local actors will delight and intrigue you as you join them on a journey through the workday of each of the uncommon, common men and women portrayed.
