INTRODUCTION TO ACTING

Students will leave this class with a basic understanding of theatre fundamentals, including stage directions and theatre terminology. They will also explore improv, scene study and performance as well as learn how to audition for a play. Best suited for actors grades 2-4.

INTERMEDIATE ACTORS' WORKSHOP

Students in this workshop will work with other ambitious actors to practice and perform monologues, dialogues and scenes.
