Class Descriptions

<u>Broadway Kids</u>: An introduction to Acting and Musical Theater. Students will learn the basics of acting, singing, and dance as they apply to Musical Theater. Each class will consist of warm-ups, technique exercises, theater games, and scene work!

<u>Musical Theater 1 & 2:</u> Especially geared for students interested in singing, dancing, and acting. This class will prepare students for all that being in a musical requires! Students will work on improving their skills in the 3 areas, as well as learning scenes and songs from many different Broadway shows!
