Dance

We offer a range of dance techniques for students in grades 6-12. Our 10-week session of classes will allow students to build the fundamentals needed to excel as a dancer or performer in the theatre!



Beginner/Intermediate Tap (Grades 6-8) Tuesdays, 6:30-7:30pm, October 4-December 6

Learn the fundamentals of Musical Theatre Tap! Link individual steps into combinations while keeping clear sounds and rhythms.

Musical Theatre Dance (Grades 6-8) Tuesdays, 7:30-8:30pm, October 4-December 6

Jazz and ballet technique, strength and flexibility, technique and performance - all rolled into one!

Intermediate/Advanced Tap (Grades 9-12) Thursdays, 5:30-6:30pm, October 6-December 15 *No Classes Thanksgiving Day

An introduction of Rhythm Tap while continuing to work on and polish the musicality and style of Musical Theatre tap concepts.

Ballet (Grades 9-12) Thursdays, 6:30-7:30pm, October 6-December 15 *No Classes Thanksgiving Day

Strengthen body and core, learn proper alignment, and develop strong ballet technique that will be essential to all other dance techniques!

Jazz (Grades 9-12) Thursdays, 7:30-8:30pm, October 6-December 12 *No Classes Thanksgiving Day

Building on concepts from Musical Theatre Dance, this class is an ideal continuation for older students, especially those preparing for college auditions!

Performing Artist's Workshop (Grades 3-6)

In this 10-session class, students will sing, dance and act using material from their favorite musicals and TV shows! We will teach the foundations of musical theatre - expanding vocabulary and building skills - all while keeping it fun. Use your imagination, be creative and build confidence!

This continued exploration of acting techniques, including Viewpoints and Meisner, will provide a leg up while preparing for community, college and professional auditions.
