Dance

We offer a range of dance techniques for students in grades 6-12. Our 10-week session of classes will allow students to build the fundamentals needed to excel as a dancer or performer in the theatre!



Beginner/Intermediate Tap (Grades 6-8)

Tuesdays, 6:30-7:30pm, October 3-December 12

Learn the fundamentals of Musical Theatre Tap! Link individual steps into combinations while keeping clear sounds and rhythms.

Musical Theatre Dance (Grades 6-8)

Tuesdays, 7:30-8:30pm, October 3-December 12

Jazz and ballet technique, strength and flexibility, technique and performance - all rolled into one!

Intermediate/Advanced Tap (Grades 9-12)

Wednesdays, 5:30-6:30pm, October 4-December 13

An introduction of Rhythm Tap while continuing to work on and polish the musicality and style of Musical Theatre tap concepts.

Ballet (Grades 9-12)

Wednesdays, 6:30-7:30pm, October 4-December 13

Strengthen body and core, learn proper alignment, and develop strong ballet technique that will be essential to all other dance techniques!

Jazz (Grades 9-12)

Wednesdays, 7:30-8:30pm, October 4-December 13

Building on concepts from Musical Theatre Dance, this class is an ideal continuation for older students, especially those preparing for college auditions!

Performing Artist's Workshop (Grades 3-5)

Saturdays, 10:30am-Noon

October 7-December 16

In this 10-session class, students will sing, dance and act using material from their favorite musicals and TV shows! We will teach the foundations of musical theatre - expanding vocabulary and building skills - all while keeping it fun. Use your imagination, be creative and build confidence!



Sing

Back for Fall 2017 - perfect for the kid who loves to sing! Students will learn healthy and relaxed singing in this exciting 10-week group class. It is an excellent option for students who are not quite ready for one-on-one voice lessons or as a supplement to their weekly lessons!

Young Voices (Grades 6-8)

Wednesdays, 5:30-6:30pm, October 4-December 13

Get prepared for your next audition! In this group vocal class, students will learn vocal technique, basic ear training and harmonization and begin to build audition material - all in this supportive and encouraging group environment.



Act

In this series of Acting Classes, students will discover and create characters, explore improvisation, and touch on a variety of acting techniques through exercises, scenes, and monologues.

Acting I (Grades 6-8)

Tuesdays, 5:30-6:30pm, October 3-December 12

Learn the foundations of a variety of acting techniques - from Uta Hagen to Stanislavsky! Explore characterization and begin building a "tool belt" of tactics to improve your confidence and performance as a young actor!

Acting II (Grades 9-12)

Tuesdays, 6:30-7:30pm, October 3-December 12

Take your tools to the next level through deeper analysis of text - at the conclusion of this 10-week course, deconstruct scenes and monologues with ease! This continued exploration of acting techniques, including Viewpoints and Meisner, will provide a leg up while preparing for community, college and professional auditions.
