JOB SUMMARY:

School of the Performing Arts is a critical division of the growing performing arts organization Proctors, serving over 40,000 children and adults each season with onsite and off-site programming. The MediaWorks is a workforce development program that pairs a professional filmmaker with a 9th grade English teacher at Schenectady High School. Together, the teaching team works in tandem to develop new routes to curriculum instruction, using arts strategies to deliver project-based learning and develop skills that will last beyond graduation. The film/media projects act as a conduit for English curriculum to ignite and excite students to therefore encourage class involvement.

This position will work with the classroom teacher to develop and implement project-based lessons for Common Core curriculum that is adaptable to different learning styles. This position will also provide the co-teacher and school with methodology and resources to include arts-based instruction and to change learning pathways for students in order to increase engagement, attendance and success.

- Act as co-teacher in classroom throughout entire year including creating lesson plans, providing support and leadership in the classroom
- Instruct students in the use of media technology while using DSLR cameras, camera accessories, computers, and editing software.
- Work as co-teacher with English teacher to integrate all film and media projects into year round curriculum appropriate for students.
- Create lesson plans for all media and video projects.
- Facilitate program documentation including student work onto vimeo, lesson plans, student evaluations, and quarterly tracking of grades and attendance.
- Promote the creative process and advocate for student voice.
- Communicate feedback, updates and obstacles to Manager.
- Offer advice, ideas, technical knowledge and experience in developing media-based projects.

- Contribute to planning sessions, curriculum development, student assessments and grading (where applicable).
- -Must present 10 completed student film projects by end of school year; with an average of 3 or more per quarter.
