Many of Proctors excellent training programs will be hosted there and new programs will be offered toward this mission in the coming years.

JOB SUMMARY:

- Each semester will end with a class showcase, and an overall school showcase.
- Classes will be year-round.

- Performance experience helpful, but not required.
- Ability to work with students with a wide range of ages and skill levels.
- Classes will be scheduled throughout the weekday and weekends.
