Beginner/Intermediate Tap (Grades 6-8) Thursdays, 7:15-8:15pm

Learn the fundamentals of Musical Theatre Tap! Link individual steps into combinations while keeping clear sounds and rhythms.

Musical Theatre Dance (Grades 6-8) Thursdays, 6:15-7:15pm

Jazz and ballet technique, strength and flexibility, technique and performance - all rolled into one!

Intermediate/Advanced Tap (Grades 9-12) Wednesdays, 6-7pm

An introduction of Rhythm Tap while continuing to work on and polish the musicality and style of Musical Theatre tap concepts.

Side-By-Side (6mos-2yrs) Thursdays, 10-10:45am

A "grown-up and me" style class, young students and their adult companion can explore new sounds and movement embracing social awareness, sensory stimulation & creative dramatic play.
