



Director Application FAQ

1. Directors may submit for one or more productions to be considered for any of the following timeslots (exact dates to be determined):
 - September 2022--Musical
 - November 2022—Youth musical cast with students in 9th-12th grades
 - January 2023--Musical
 - March 2023--Musical
 - May 2023--Musical
 - July 2023—Non-musical Play
2. Directors and their teams must agree to and follow SLOC's COVID guidelines including all safety policies and procedures which will be provided to you if requested or if you are selected to direct. The procedures will include vaccination requirements, temperature and symptom checks, distancing, PPE use, etc.
3. We strive to celebrate diversity in our community. Each production team is expected to work with SLOC leadership to meet our company goals of diversity, inclusivity, and representation in cast, crew, and production roles.
4. Directors will be given a limited artistic budget to execute their vision. The cost of musicians and performance rights will be paid for by the company and will not need to be accounted for by the production team. All other production staff are volunteer positions.
5. Cast size is to be limited to 15 or less. We request directors have the minimum number of cast members possible.
6. The orchestra will be limited to 4 or fewer paid players.

8. Generally, we try to avoid repeating shows that SLOC has produced in the last 10 years. Review a list of our past productions on our website here: <http://slotheater.org/past-productions/>.
9. Directors must submit their application by 6pm on 2/6/2022. Please submit by emailing applications to showrecommendation@slotheater.org.
10. Once your application is received, the show recommendation committee will review it and you may be contacted for an interview. You will be informed via email as to whether or not your submission has been chosen by the Board of Directors.
