



Director Application FAQ

1. Directors may submit for one or more productions to be considered for any of the following timeslots (exact dates to be determined):
 - September 2023
 - November 2023
 - January 2024
 - March 2024
 - May 2024
2. Directors and their teams must agree to and follow SLOC's COVID guidelines including all safety policies and procedures which will be provided to you if requested or if you are selected to direct. The procedures will include vaccination requirements, testing, and masking requirements, etc.
3. We strive to celebrate diversity in our community. Each production team is expected to work with SLOC leadership to meet our company goals of diversity, inclusivity, and representation in cast, crew, and production roles.
4. Directors will be given a limited artistic budget to execute their vision (\$3000). The cost of musicians and performance rights will be paid for by the company and will not need to be accounted for by the production team. All other production staff are volunteer positions. SLOC offers a large costume shop, brand new lighting and sound systems, some available set pieces, and a prop collection to supplement your production's requirements.
5. The orchestra will be limited to 4 or fewer paid players. Volunteer pit members are always welcome.

7. Generally, we try to avoid repeating shows that SLOC has produced in the last 10 years. Review a list of our past productions on our website here: <http://sloctheater.org/past-productions/>.
8. Directors must submit their application by 6pm on 1/2/23. Please submit by emailing applications to showrecommendation@sloctheater.org. Please add your producer, music director, and choreographer on the Cc line of your email when submitting your application.
9. Once your application is received, the show recommendation committee will review it and you may be contacted for an interview. You will be informed via email as to whether your submission has been chosen by the Board of Directors.
